

## **ATTACHMENT 1: ABSTRACT**

The ADAMH Board of Franklin County, in collaboration with Franklin County Children Services, Franklin County Common Pleas Court, Division of Domestic Relations and Juvenile Branch, and Franklin County Family and Children First Council, has developed, implemented and expanded a model to meet the treatment and support needs of youth and their families who, at a minimum, are seriously emotionally disturbed, substance abusing, serious juvenile offenders and may be involved in the child welfare system.

The proposed model will move a youth from the Franklin County Juvenile Court Pre-Sentence Investigation through a screening and assessment process that involves a care coordinator who facilitates the delivery of service throughout the program. Care coordinators engage families and provide linkage and bridging to evidenced-based treatment services including MST, FFT, and MDFT. The service delivery team includes the youth and family, probation officer, school, family defined support, treatment providers and other system representatives as necessary. Our proposal will continue to improve intersystem communication and shared outcomes among the behavioral healthcare, juvenile justice, and child welfare systems.
