

ADDENDUM TO ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE
TRADING PARTNER AND BUSINESS ASSOCIATE AGREEMENT
[ADAMH/CMH/ADAS Board and State (ODMH/ODADAS)]

Section 4.2.3 of the ELECTRONIC DATA INTERCHANGE TRADING PARTNER AND BUSINESS ASSOCIATE AGREEMENT ("Agreement") entered into by and between _____ ("Partner" and "Covered Entity") and the State of Ohio, Departments of Mental Health ("ODMH") and Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services ("ODADAS") (collectively "State" and "Business Associate") on _____, 2003 is hereby amended to state the following:

"4.2.3 Business Associate may aggregate data for the MACSIS Data Mart and ODADAS may aggregate data for the ODADAS BH Data Mart. ODMH and/or ODADAS may aggregate all Medicaid and non-Medicaid claims and enrollment data, including both mental health and alcohol and other drug abuse related claims for purposes relating to administration of Ohio's Medicaid program. ODMH may use client specific claims and enrollment data and, as necessary, merge such data with the client's PCS data, Outcomes data and/or Behavioral Health Module data, in order to evaluate, on an aggregated basis, patterns of service utilization, service effectiveness and cost effectiveness, for analyses relating to the health care operations of the Covered Entity, as approved by the Data Use Subgroup of the Executive Policy Management Committee and agreed to by ODMH. For purposes identified as above, ODMH may receive from ODADAS the Mental Health Behavioral Health Module data for use alone, or in conjunction with the other identified data bases.
