

ODJFS will be migrating from the MMIS system to the MITS system starting July 20, 2011 with completion on August 2, 2011. During this "black out" period, ODJFS will not be processing claims from sister state agencies, including ODADAS and ODMH, for reimbursement of FFP. ODADAS and ODMH will continue to process claims in MACSIS and create ODJFS claim files during the "black out" period but these files will not be submitted to ODJFS until ODJFS resumes claims processing for ODADAS and ODMH on August 3, 2011. Boards need to continue to pay providers and certify payments in the mCPE application during the "black out" period.

Summary of important claim process dates:

July 20, 2011 - MMIS closure and last day for ODADAS or ODMH to submit file for MMIS processing.

July 22, 2011 - Last MMIS adjudication date for Medicaid claims submitted by ODADAS or ODMH.

July 25, 2011 - Last MMIS pay file ODADAS or ODMH will receive.

August 3, 2011 - First day ODADAS or ODMH can submit claim files to ODJFS for MITS processing.

It is extremely important that Boards remember to check their claims extracts before reversing any claims during this "black out" period, especially since claims will continue to process in MACSIS and the mCPE application is still active for payment certification. If a claim has a value in the ODHSEXDT field and no value in the HSDTPAID field in the claims extract **DO NOT REVERSE THE CLAIM**. If there is a value in the ODHSEXDT field, and no value in the HSDTPAID field, the claim has been extracted from Diamond but has not come back from ODJFS. If you reverse the claim before it comes back from ODJFS, and ODJFS denies the claim, there will be two negative **ACPAY** records. This will result in the amount being taken back from the provider twice. Diamond will show only one reversal line in the claim detail, but two ACPAY records will exist.
