Health Home Consumer Enrollment/Disenrollment Information

Providers certified by ODMH as Health Homes have the ability to enroll or disenroll consumers into their Health Homes using Ohio's Medicaid Information Technology (MITS) Web Portal. Only clients who are enrolled in Ohio Medicaid may receive Health Home services. The Health Home-related functions are built in MITS to support the effective delivery of integrated physical and behavioral health care and comprehensive care coordination services to eligible consumers, and actively manage their Health Home enrollment.

How Can Non-Health Home Providers Find Out if a Consumer is Enrolled in a Health Home?

It is critical for non-Health Home providers (especially hospitals, emergency rooms and primary care physicians) to know whether a patient is enrolled in a Medicaid Health Home. This information is essential to accomplishing the goals of comprehensive care coordination. MITS has a search function that any Medicaid provider, including community mental health agencies that are **NOT** Health Homes, can use to determine whether a Medicaid client is enrolled in a Health Home.

Below is a screen shot from MITS showing how to search for a client's Health Home enrollment under the MITS Portal Eligibility Search menu. Complete the information under "Eligibility Verification Request." If the client is enrolled in a Health Home, the information will display as noted below in the "Lock In" panel. Note that the name of the Health Home agency is also listed, along with a contact telephone number.

Using the 270/271 Transactions to Research Health Home Enrollment

Any Medicaid provider certified to submit 270/271 EDI transactions may also check a client's Health Home enrollment using the 270/271 file. Health Home enrollment will be identified as "Mental Health Homes Assignment Plan."
