




If you or your child have a serious mental health condition, a Medicaid Health Home can help you get the services you need.

How much does this cost?

There is no additional cost. Medicaid Health Home services are covered under your current Medicaid plan.

Where are Medicaid Health Homes available?

Starting in October 2012, Medicaid Health Homes will be available in Lucas, Butler, Adams, Lawrence and Scioto counties (the counties shown in blue below). Additional Medicaid Health Homes will be launched throughout 2013.
