

Map Information:

This map examines daily morphine milligram equivalents (MMEs) per capita in 2011. Most prescription analgesics in the OARRS system (>97%) have a morphine equivalence as established by the Centers for Disease Control. Enough analgesics were prescribed in Ohio for every man, woman and child to receive 57.3 mg of daily MME during the course of the year. Counties with the highest daily MMEs per capita were Jackson (95.1 mg), Brown (90.2 mg) and Gallia (90.2 mg). Counties with the lowest daily MMEs per capita were Holmes (18.3 mg), Mercer (28.3 mg) and Putnam (29.5 mg).

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
