Map Information:

This map represents county-level data on mentions of heroin in case manager reports for unique families per 1,000 families living in the county. In 2013, there were an average of 5.1 mentions of heroin in case manager reports statewide. Counties with the highest rates per 1,000 families were Richland (20.9), Marion (16.9) and Clinton (11.3). Counties with the lowest rates per 1,000 families were Holmes (0.5), Morgan (0.6) and Wyandot (0.7).

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
