


# Persons Living with HIV/AIDS in Ohio

2005 Health HIV/AIDS Surveillance Program


## Legend

## Map Information:

This map represents the rate of all persons ever diagnosed and reported with HIV or AIDS who have not been reported as having died per 100,000. Research has shown that behaviors associated with substance abuse, including intravenous drug use and increased risky sexual contact, are among the most significant factors in the spread of HIV infection. In 2005, the highest HIV/AIDS rates were in Franklin (247.0), Cuyahoga (228.8) and Hamilton (217.1) counties.
