Snapshot of Prison Census January 1, 2006

Map Information:

This map displays incarcerations for drug offenses by committing county. A snapshot of the prison population on January 1, 2006 showed there were 7,448 drug-related incarcerations with a statewide average rate of 6.5 incarcerations per 10,000 persons. Scioto (20.6), Defiance (13.8) and Hamilton (13.7) counties had the highest drug-related incarceration rates per 10,000 persons. Counties with the lowest drug-related incarceration rates per 10,000 persons were Perry (0.3), Morrow (0.3) and Harrison (0.6).

Note: Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Boards have black borders, and counties have white borders. Borders are black in cases where ADAMHS boards and counties have the same borders.
