What is the Access to Recovery

Ohio's four-year, \$13 million "Access to Recovery" (ATR) grant, is funded by the federal Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration and administered by the Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services. ATR provides free access to alcohol and other drug treatment and recovery support services to Ohio National Guard service members, all active duty personnel and veterans who live in Cuyahoga, Lorain, Mahoning, Stark and Summit Counties, who are struggling with substance abuse issues, and who do not currently have health insurance coverage.

To obtain services – including, but not limited to, outpatient and intensive outpatient treatment, counseling, parenting classes, employment training, transportation assistance, transitional housing, childcare and support groups – military service members may do one of three things: 1) Make an appointment with Ohio National Guard Prevention and Treatment Outreach Coordinator Sergeant Cheryl Danielson (614-336-6444); 2) Make an appointment with Ohio National Guard Director of Psychological Health Jeremy Kaufman, Psy.D. (614-336-7246); 3) Contact an ATR Benefits Coordination site in their county of residence for an anonymous referral (see list below).
