Welcome

Dawn welcomed the committee members to the conference call and took attendance. The committee was asked to review the meeting minutes from the February 12, 2014 conference call meeting. There were no revisions or additions. Eloise Traina made a motion for the minutes to be approved as written and Michael Langford seconded the motion. The minutes from the 2/12/14 meeting were accepted as written.

SAMHSA Updates

Dawn informed the committee that Ohio received approval for the no-cost extension for the SPF SIG Project until December 31, 2014. The 13 SPF SIG sub-recipient communities would not receive additional funding but would receive additional implementation time. John Boley inquired about the length of time and Dawn responded that sub-recipient communities would have until the end of September. The OSET Team will collect the data and OhioMHAS and OSET will work together to get the data entered into the system for final federal reporting to SAMHSA CSAP.

Department Updates – N/A

Dawn informed the committee that SAMHSA released the Request for Proposal for the Strategic Prevention Framework Partnerships for Success (SPF-PFS) Initiative. Ohio is eligible and intends to apply for the SPF PFS, the deadline is May 14, 2014.

Training Updates

Tracee Garrett gave an update on training. Global Insight has been busy providing last minute training for sub-recipient communities. Prevention 101 Training has been extremely popular and Franklin

County has implemented 2 of these trainings as well as Environmental Prevention Strategies. There have been 3 webinars focused on sustainability and they will be on the new website. Global has continued to work with OhioMHAS IT staff and the website is 90% complete. The team continues to migrate information from the old website and plans to have it completed by June 15, 2014. There will be an asynchronous webinar available as a tutorial to help users learn how to navigate the new site.

OSAM and SEOW Updates

Nick Martt provided the following SEOW updates:

2. Ohio Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance Survey: Data sent to IT, currently being cleaned and processed.
3. Unintentional Drug Deaths by County: Data being sent to IT today.
4. Website issues: Currently being worked on by IT
 - a. False zeroes within graphs
 - b. Error messages

SPF SIG Sub-Recipient Update

Nicole Yandell provided an update on the status of Ohio's SPF SIG sub-recipient communities. All sub-recipients have completed the Needs Assessment phase so there is nothing new to report. All sub-recipients have completed their Community Logic Models and Strategic Plans. Currently everyone is in implementation phase. There is 1 county that still needs Media Plan Approval. Sustainability plans are due on April 30, 2014. Detailed information on the status of Ohio's sub-recipient communities can be found in the OSET Update 4/23/14 (see attached).

SPF SIG EBP Workgroup

Dawn provided an update on the SPF EBP Workgroup. The SPF EBP Workgroup has reviewed the Ohio Youth Led Prevention Network Toolkit and will also provide feedback for the Ohio Coalition of Excellence certification. This group has remained dedicated to the SPF SIG process and will continue will to sustain after the SPF SIG project has ended.

IHE Initiative

Nicole Yandell provided an update on the IHE Initiative. OSET has been working with the participating colleges/universities over the past year providing technical assistance and support as needed. The sustainability plans were due on April 15 and all plans have been received except for Terra. The

participating schools have decided to go with Campus Clarity in the future because it was the program that best fit their needs.

Additional Committee Updates

Dawn Thomas announced that the Ohio Prevention & Early Intervention Conference (OPEC) is being held June 2-5, 2014 on the campus of Ohio Wesleyan University in Delaware, Ohio. The theme is Transforming Wellness for Ohio's Children, Families & Communities. Registration information is available at www.DrugFreeActionAlliance.org

Marcie Seidel announced that the Ohio Youth Led Prevention Network will hold its annual rally on Wednesday, April 30, 2014 in Columbus, Ohio. The rally will begin at the Columbus commons and march to the Statehouse. Currently there are approximately 1800 people registered to attend.
