**Priority Substance: Alcohol**  
**Target Consumption Patterns: Underage (18-20 year olds) use of Alcohol**  
**Target Population: 18-20 year old students at "XYZ University"**

<b>Problem Statement</b>		
The majority of underage students (18-20) at XYZ University report using alcohol in the past 30 days.		
<b>Description of the Problem</b>	<b>Intervening Variables</b>	<b>Strategies</b>
<p><b>Current Use of Alcohol by Students Aged 18-20</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>61% of current students aged 18-20 report current use of alcohol (using in past 30 days). ("XYZ University" campus survey, 2012).</li> </ul> <p><b>Report of harmful effects of alcohol use by students aged 18-20.</b></p>	<p><u><b>Risk Factors:</b></u></p> <p><b>There is a low perception of disapproval of alcohol use among underage students on campus.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>67% of 18-20 year olds that do not disapprove of someone their age having 1-2 drinks/day of an alcoholic beverage. ("XYZ University" campus survey, 2012).</li> <li>77% of 18-20 report said often or sometimes their friends encouraged them to get drunk ("XYZ University" campus survey, 2012).</li> </ul> <p><b>Underage students are experiencing the harmful effects of alcohol use, yet there is still a low perception of disapproval of alcohol use among underage students on campus.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>48% of underage respondents report experiencing harmful effects of alcohol. Of those experiencing harmful effects of alcohol, 29% of 18-20 year old respondents reported having a hangover within the past 2 months and 18% reported vomiting from drinking within the past 2 months. ("XYZ University" campus survey, 2012).</li> </ul> <p><u><b>Protective Factor:</b></u></p> <p><b>There is an existing infrastructure on campus that is focused on substance use prevention and intervention.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trained Peer Educators of C.H.O.I.C.E.S and GAMMA.
